Stochastic Geometry Modeling and Optimization of Cellular Networks – Bridging Accuracy and Complexity

In the past few years, there have been many efforts to develop analytical methodologies for optimizing very ultra-dense networks, especially by using the mathematical tools of stochastic geometry and point processes. At the time of writing, however, we have understood that many proposed approaches have limitations that make them unsuitable for optimizing cellular networks. In this talk, Marco Di Renzo will describe two recent approaches that have been proposed recently by him to overcome these limitations.
